4. To engage the community in preventive measures against drug abuse.

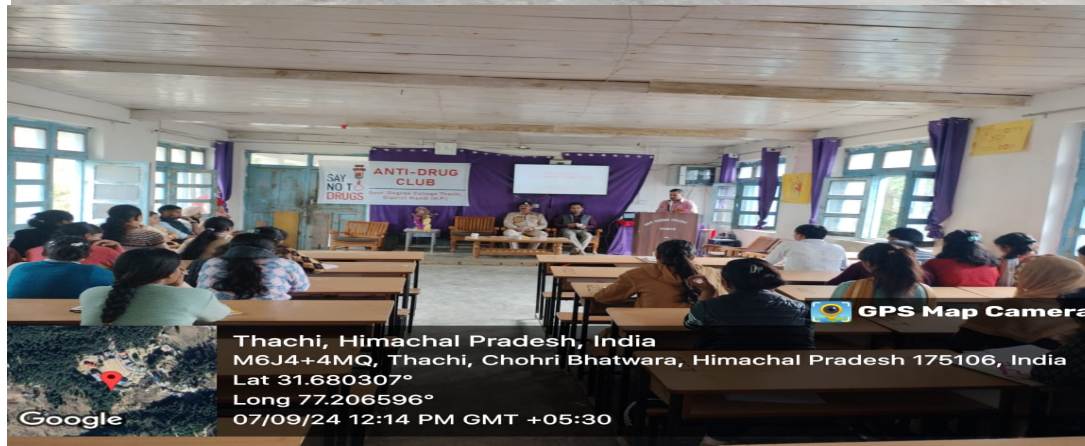
#### **Conclusion:**
